How can you help?

How to use this prayer guide:

COMMIT to pray for victims of human trafficking for the next 30 days.

SHARE these prayers with your friends, family, or church family.
Ask them to join you in prayer.


PRAY using the listed prayers and Bible verses.

Follow the three sections of this prayer guide to:

- Pray for men, women, and children currently trapped in human trafficking.
- Pray for ministries and organizations combating human trafficking.
- Pray for men, women, and children who are recovering from the trauma of trafficking

Rescue

1. *Read Jeremiah 29:11*

Pray for those who are experiencing powerlessness, desperation, and hopelessness. Ask God to grant them hope for a new future.

2. *Read Psalm 10:17*

Pray human trafficking victims would know that God hears the deepest.

3. *Read Psalm 120:1*

Pray that the Holy Spirit would bring hope and encouragement to those who need it and in the moments they need it most.

4. *Read Psalm 9:9*

Pray that the Holy Spirit would bring hope and encouragement to those who need it and in the moments they need it most.

5. *Read Psalm 36:7*

Pray that God would protect the children of human trafficking victims from exploitation.

6. *Read Proverbs 31:8*

Pray for those with intellectual disabilities who are being exploited and have little to no say in what happens to them.

7. *Read Romans 12:21*

Pray for traffickers, that they would see the evil of slavery and repent of their ways.

8. *Read Ephesians 3:17-19*

Pray that deep sense of God's love and compassion would fill the hearts of human trafficking victims.

9. *Read Philippians 4:19*

Pray that God would provide the funds needed to construct safe facilities.

10. *Read Proverbs 2:6*

Pray that God would grant caregivers in group homes the grace, wisdom, and strength they need as they face difficult decisions.

Notes

Restore

11. *Read Psalm 34:22*

Pray that care homes would be able to nurture trafficking survivors and provide them with the emotional safety they need.

12. *Read Psalm 5:12*

Pray that ministries who work with human trafficking victims would find favor with government officials.

13. *Read Psalm 82:3*

Pray that support for human trafficking ministries would pour out in their times of need.

14. *Read Nehemiah 9:27*

Pray that those ministering to human trafficking survivors would have open hearts and that they would be tangible examples of God's love.

15. *Read Galatians 6:9*

Pray that churches around the world would rise up and protect marginalized people who are in danger of trafficking.

16. *Read Proverbs 18:15*

Pray that God would provide funds for those who are beginning advanced educational programs and trainings.

17. *Read Proverbs 16:3*

Pray that God would give the directors of human trafficking ministries the creativity and innovation they need to plan their programs.

18. *Read Psalm 37:23–24*

Pray that minds and hearts would unify in ministry for victims of human trafficking.

19. *Read Psalm 147:3*

Pray that God would work in the hearts of trafficking victims and that He would heal their brokenness, grief, and anger.

20. *Read Philippians 4:7*

Pray that those experiencing nightmares and flashbacks would find God's supernatural peace.

Empower

21. Read Colossians 3:17

Pray for those who are working hard to continue or complete their education.

22. Read Isaiah 61:1

Pray that those being cared for in special homes and programs would be equipped to help others in the future.

23. Read Genesis 50:20

Pray that God would continue to redeem bad situations for His glory.

24. Read Psalm 90:17

Pray for those who are learning new job skills, that they would be equipped to provide for themselves and their families.

25. Read Ecclesiastes 9:10

Pray that those who are enrolled in nursing programs would find jobs when they graduate.

26. Read Psalm 103:6

Pray justice will come quickly for those who have ongoing court cases.

27. Read 2 Peter 1:2

Pray that victims would find freedom and healing from their trauma.

28. Read Psalm 72:4

Pray that victims who have children would continue to learn how to be good parents.

29. Read Psalm 74:21

Pray for those who are moving out of care facilities, that they would feel empowered as they pursue new jobs or education programs.

30. Read Isaiah 58:6

Pray that those who have been rescued from the physical chains of exploitation would also experience true spiritual freedom.
