Ministry Centers

Send Relief ministry centers deliver compassion ministry within local communities while providing mission trips and training opportunities for churches all over the country. The goal of ministry centers is twofold: serve communities well and encourage others to do the same.

All over North America, Send Relief ministry centers actively assess community needs, develop ministry strategies, deliver ministry and provide opportunities for others to go on mission.

Community Snapshot

If you are looking for a place in New York City with sports, art, history, nature and fantastic food, the Bronx is the place to visit. The Mott Haven neighborhood in the South Bronx is a vibrant neighborhood steps away from convenient transportation into the city. Before the 1950s, the neighborhood primarily included European immigrants. Later, many African Americans and new immigrants from Puerto Rico settled in the new public housing projects.

- Mott Haven is home to approximately 90,000 people, 30,000 of whom are under 18. The population is predominantly (96%) minority—African, African American and Latino. Many are newly arrived immigrants from Western Africa and Latin America.
- The Bronx has a very young population (with **34.6%** aged 19 years old or less) and has the highest proportion of children (**29.8%**) of all New York State counties.
- According to the 2010 census, Mott Haven has the highest poverty rate (**38%**) in the nation, the lowest median income and the highest proportion of children living below poverty (**49%**) in the U.S. New York City Administration for Children's Services (ACS) has designated this community an area of high need. It has the highest number of foster care placements in the entire city.

- More than **75% of youth living** in the community live in nontraditional households (single parents, grandparents, etc.), with over 80% of those in single-parent homes. Less than 15% of the children live with their biological fathers.
- **90%** of the area's residents received aid, primarily families with dependent children.
- One in five young adults in Mott Haven is considered "idle." They are not in school and are not employed. More than **46%** of the adult residents in the community are not in the workforce, including **11%** of officially unemployed adult residents.



- **13%** of all births in the community were to teen mothers.
- Less than **70%** of students graduate from high school.

"The aim of our ministry, locally and citywide, is to have healthy churches planted and growing within communities of need," ministry center director Andrew Mann explains. "Locally, Graffiti 2 Baptist Church is a growing body of believers that has emerged from our ministry to the neighborhood. Other sites and affiliates that emerge will have the same goal. The aim isn't only to meet needs through ministry, but also see faith grow and churches built through community-ministry based church planting."

History of the New York City Ministry Center

The Graffiti Network of ministries and churches believe following Jesus means sharing God's love in tangible ways in the most challenging places. Their strategy is to meet needs, build relationships and allow God to transform lives by ministering to the holistic needs of individuals (physical, mental, emotional, social and spiritual).

Graffiti 2 Community Ministries has served within Mott Haven since 2005. Children and families in that community are particularly vulnerable to Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) due to the predominance of risk

factors involving education, health, safety, family and environment.

With Send Relief, the core of Graffiti 2's mission focuses on children, teens and families. Graffiti 2's after-school and summer sports programs provide participants with a safe environment, holistic enrichment and meaningful relationships, all proven to prevent or minimize the harmful long-term effects of ACEs.

The New York City Ministry Center provides a supportive environment for children, teens

and adults to build meaningful relationships that last a lifetime. These relationships offer stability, counsel, encouragement and mentoring.

Through this commitment to providing a safe environment, holistic enrichment and meaningful relationships, the Ministry Center provides healing and hope to those suffering trauma, and changes lives by introducing children, teens and adults to a Savior that redeems all brokenness.
